Richard Shoemaker, Sr, PE: Served as 3rd chapter president 1951/1952.

Richard joined his father, Forest Shoemaker, in the air conditioning company in 1946 after he obtained his mechanical engineering degree from Purdue University. He was Registered as a PE in 1963. His Son, Rick, Jr and Grandson Richard III are still active in the family business. Richard, Sr has passed away.



Jack Tumilty, PE: Served as 11th chapter president 1959/1960.

Graduated mechanical engineering from University of Oklahoma in 1946 and joined Collins Engineering, OKC, in 1951 and was registered in 1952. He moved to Tulsa in 1952 with Collins Engineering and later became VP of the company. Jack serviced as the first Chair of ASHRAE's first energy **Standard 90** and was on the committee from 1974 through 1980. His ASHRAE awards include Chapter Service, Regional Award of Merit, Distinguished Service, ASHRAE Fellow and Distinguished 50 Year Member. Our chapter honors Jack's name with the Jack Tumilty Scholarship Award. Jack has passed away.
