Meet Northeast Oklahoma 2024 Hall of Fame Inductee who will be formally inducted at Chapter Meeting in March 2024




Mike Beda served as our chapter's fifty-second President in 2000/01. He graduated with a BS degree in Engineering Operations from Iowa State University in 1969 and is a registered professional engineer in Oklahoma. After graduation, he joined The Marley Company, as an application engineer for HVAC and small industrial cooling towers. In 1972 he joined Process Equipment Company in Oklahoma City, as office manager. In 1990 and took over the ownership of Process Equipment Company. In 1993 he moved to Tulsa. In 2017 he sold the company to Midwest Machinery Company of St Louis, Missouri. Mike joined ASHRAE in 1973. He served as President of the Central Oklahoma Chapter in 1981 and won the Region VIII Golden Gavel Award that year. He served as President of the Northeastern Oklahoma Chapter in 1999-2000.

He served as Region VIII Vice Chairmen for Membership Promotion in 1984 to 87 and became Chairmen of the Society Membership Promotion Committee in 1988. Other Society work include Society Director at Large/Board of Directors 2002 to 05, Chairman of the Society TEGA Committee,1992, Society Nominating Committee Region VIII Member,1993 to 96, Society Chapters Programs Committee Chairman,1995, Standards APC Subcommittee Chairman, 2000, Standards Reaffirmation Subcommittee Chair, 2009, and Technology Operations Subcommittee Chair, 2010. Mike has received the Chapter Service Award, the Regional Award of Merit, the Society Distin-

guished Service Award, the Society Exceptional Service Award, the Central Oklahoma Chapter Hall of Fame Award and is an ASHRAE Life Member. Now retired, Mike is currently NEOK Chapter Chair of the Honors & Awards Committee, Region VIII Newsletter Judging Committee Chair and Region VIII Honors and Awards Committee Chair.



Mark is currently Executive Director of the Norman Asbjornson Innovation Center in Tulsa. He holds 2 USA Patents covering High Induction Diffusers and Low Leak Air Dampers. Mark joined ASHRAE in 1985. He attended Society meetings and in 1986 and volunteered to revise Chapter 46 of the Handbook for TC 6.9 covering Thermal Storage. This volunteering also led to working on Societies Special Publications, Certification Development, and Ethics Rules. He was elected to ASHRAE's Board of Directors as 'Director at Large' in 2014 through 2017. In 2019 he was appointed to the Region VIII Nominating Committee as Alternate and Member. Mark has received the Distinguished Service Award, the Exceptional Service Award and is an ASHRAE Fellow. He is currently a Distinguished Lecturer for Society .
